AHG collaborates with Focus on the Family to instill a strong biblical worldview in the next generation of godly women

CINCINNATI, Ohio — A casual approach toward the inherent value of human life has infiltrated every corner of modern society, and unfortunately American youth are being directly influenced. [More than half](#) of Generation Z (ages 13-28) believe that women should have the right to abort their children at any stage of pregnancy. For Christian parents raising young women in this misguided culture, the pressure to impart a biblical worldview in the face of such negativity and evil can be overwhelming.

To provide parents with the tools necessary to raise godly women of integrity with a strong biblical worldview, *American Heritage Girls* (AHG, www.americanheritagegirls.org) *Founder and Executive Director Patti Garibay* collaborated with Focus on the Family's Dr. Danny Huerta to provide [a video series](#) detailing how parents can help their daughters adrift in today's post-Christian culture. The series helps parents understand the cultural pressures facing their girls in today's modern era, examine the basics of a Christian worldview and how they impact young women, and discover practical tips for helping their girls remain grounded in their faith amidst societal pressures.

"We live in a day and age where life, in all of its ages and stages, is taken for granted," said Garibay. "More than ever before, it is vital to defend the right to life. We are called to be light in the darkness. God designed the most majestic mountains and the unknown depths of the seas. He placed countless constellations in time and space. He formed the most distant galaxies unseen to the naked human eye, but we, His people, remain His most treasured, beloved creation.

"It makes sense, then, that in our current world, the most precious gift of our creation would be under attack. The sanctity of unborn life, the dignity of disabled, ill, or elderly life, the beauty of male and female creation — they all fall prey as victims of uncertainty or disagreement in our world. To counter this culture, it's up to parents to empower the next generation of girls to stand for God's timeless truths by instilling a biblical worldview!"

Garibay discussed the importance of empowering the next generation of women to be advocates for the unborn on the latest episode of *AHG's* podcast, [Raising Godly Girls \(RGG\)](#), with renowned pro-life advocate Abby

Johnson. Johnson's journey from Planned Parenthood clinic director to outspoken champion for life has inspired countless individuals to recognize the sanctity of life and act boldly to protect it. **Garibay** and Johnson explore practical ways to teach the next generation to stand for life with courage, grace and truth, and Johnson shares her personal story of transformation, the pivotal moment that changed her life, and how parents can equip young women to face cultural challenges with faith and conviction.

This gives **AHG** girls the important social experience of interacting with friends and godly mentors of various ages; members also learn leadership skills within a group setting. **AHG** Troops are located in [local communities](#) across the nation. If none exists in a given area, families can bring the **AHG** Program to their own area. An **American Heritage Girls** Troop Development Coach is available to provide resources to potential Charter Organizations and other families to form [a new Troop](#). Thousands of volunteer members across the country are helping girls grow in their faith, cultivate a heart for service, enjoy the great outdoors, and have more fun than they can imagine.
